Their Stories Our Mission

Founded in 2019, ISF embodies our hopes and dreams of making a profound difference in the lives of children. We believe every child is entitled to the pursuit of happiness and prosperity, regardless of the conditions they've been born into.

Our mission is to support the well being and care of children in order to protect them from the consequences of poverty. We intend to carry this out through close collaboration with groups and organizations that support similar objectives. By bringing our knowledge and expertise to bear, we believe we can significantly magnify the care the children receive.



Mission Beneficiaries

Our focus is on building a foundation of basic care such as shelter, providing opportunities for education, and keeping families together when possible. Often the children we serve face a variety of challenges:



The Orphaned

At risk of neglect and identity crises without family support, suffering from severe physical, mental, and emotional hardships.



The Vulnerable

Often victims of human trafficking, facing severe threats to their safety, rights, and dignity.



The Impoverished

Grapple with limited access to education and healthcare, which hampers their growth and future prospects.

A Child's Story

Born in 2010 and diagnosed with ADHD, he has faced life's hurdles alongside his mother, who sustains their family through informal work. A recent injury impeding her ability to work has brought new challenges, placing their stability at risk.

In response, ISF and Blue Dragon Children's Foundation have joined forces to provide a lifeline. Our support package includes:

- 1. Rent assistance to secure their shelter.
- 2. Continued education to nurture his potential.
- 3. Healthcare for his mother's rehabilitation.
- 4. A bicycle to maintain his access to education.

With this support, we hope to provide their family the footing to stand on their own.



A Student's Story

As a second-year student at PNV, she initially had limited knowledge of technology and English. Now, her aspiration is to become a front-end engineer and provide financial support for her family.

- She aims to become a front-end developer and create applications that improve people's lives. She doesn't want her mother to worry or struggle to earn every penny to support her anymore. Instead, she wants to take good care of her family.
- Grateful for the opportunity she received, she is determined to support children in remote areas in the future; drawing from her own experiences of how limited access to resources can impact someones life.

Her experience at PNV has empowered her to break free from traditional expectations and pursue her goals with confidence. She is committed to continuous improvement and hopes to inspire and support disadvantaged children to achieve their dreams, while also providing for her family.




A Student's Story

In the past, her future seemed like a string of monotonous days, filled with uninspiring jobs, limited opportunities to make new friends, and a lack of chances for further education. However, her journey stands as a testament to her resilience and determination.

- Faced challenges in adapting to technology due to no prior experience and had to persuade her skeptical parents of the value of an education in tech.
- Her perspective on the future shifted significantly after joining the program, seeing it as a chance to move beyond farming and expand her horizons beyond her village.

She now sees technology as a tool for empowerment and is determined to secure her dream job and continue the good traditions of previous generations. Her story exemplifies the ambition of the young women our organization supports through PNV as they overcome obstacles and work towards their dreams.



A Student's Story

Originally doubtful of her ability to learn English, let alone programming languages, her participation in the PNV program has led to remarkable growth in both her technical skills and English proficiency.

- The supportive and interactive learning environment helped her overcome initial challenges with computers and programming languages.
- Exposure to technology and interactions with foreigners have motivated her to pursue a career as a quality tester.

She is grateful for the support from donors, which has enabled her personal and professional development. She aspires to secure a job after graduation to support her family and inspire others in similar situations.

Patterns & Trends

X Urban vs. Rural Disparities

Children in rural areas are at a disadvantage with limited access to healthcare and education, contributing to a persistent gap in life chances compared to urban children. Rural children face barriers that stifle their development and perpetuate cycles of poverty.

Effects of Global Health Crises:

Global health crises, particularly the COVID-19 pandemic, have severely disrupted children's lives, leading to loss of caregivers, increased poverty, and a significant rise in learning poverty, as millions were and some continue to be out of school.

X Educational Deficits:

Educational deficits remain a barrier, with children in impoverished regions lacking basic literacy and numeracy skills, which are crucial for their future economic independence and ability to break free from the cycle of poverty.

X Child Labor Trends:

Child labor continues to be a dire consequence of poverty, with children in the poorest households having to forgo education to contribute to family income, often under hazardous conditions.

X Digital Divide

The digital divide has widened the gap in educational opportunities, with children in underprivileged areas lacking access to digital learning resources, exacerbating existing inequalities in education and future job prospects.

✓ Holistic NGO Interventions:

NGOs are shifting towards more holistic, sustainable approaches that prioritize long-term empowerment of children through education and skills training alongside immediate aid.



Goals: Equip students with essential tech skills for employment.Foster skilled developers ready for the tech industry.














2023 Financials




Endowment Projection 2023

2024 Outlook

As we look ahead, our unwavering mission is to empower every child in need. Our 2024 strategy has mindfully been thought out to meet the challenge:

- Fundraising Innovation:
 Launch targeted campaigns
 aiming to double our impact,
 ~\$34k. Deploy cutting-edge
 digital outreach to tap into
 new donor segments.
- **Grant Acquisition:** Intensify grant-seeking efforts by submitting a minimum of 1 high-potential proposal each quarter, focusing on sustainability and educational initiatives.



2024 Outlook Cont.

- Strategic Alliances: Strengthen existing partnerships and forge at least two new strategic partnerships with key educational institutions in the United States, sharing resources and expertise.
- Leadership Expansion: Actively recruit three new board members with diverse skill sets and a shared vision for global child empowerment; enhancing our strategic decision-making capacity.
